Having your water tested every 2 weeks is recommended to maintain proper water balance.

The following are ideal balance levels:

- Chlorine 1 - 3 ppm
- pH 7.4 - 7.8
- Total Alkalinity 125 – 150 ppm
- Calcium Hardness 175 – 225 ppm

**Remember,**

- Water must be tested within 2 hours of taking sample
- Pump must be running 48 hrs prior to taking sample
- Take water sample 18" below surface **not** in front of a jet
